Ladies – you can hit it further

It is true that ladies do not hit the ball as far as men because they do not have the physical equipment to generate comparable clubhead speed.

A lady must realise that distance comes from clubhead speed correctly applied. To swing the club into the ball on a shallow arc in the impact area she must use her arms, wrists and hands earlier in the downswing than a man does.

Make a conscious effort to get the arms going early in the downswing to achieve maximum clubhead speed and a 'flush' hit at impact.
