How many times have you been told to keep your body still when you chip? If you have, ignore it! When playing a chip shot allow the hips and shoulders to rotate through the shot to almost face your target, this will ensure that the club continues to accelerate through impact and prevent the hands from 'scooping' or 'flicking' when the ball is struck!
