
#### Interclub by Christian Holst

PRO TIP – Peter Ashdown



The aim of practise is to build a picture in your "minds eye" of each of these key moments in the swing and then make these pictures flow from one to the next. The key moment in any golf swing is the transition from 2 to 3 but the way you move from 1 to 2 will determine what your chances are of achieving that all important transition. The balance the player achieves in position 4 usually reflects the quality of the swing. The better the balance, the better the swing.
