Bunker Practice the right way

Gary Player was a great bunker player. One of the reasons he became so good was the way he practised with a dozen balls. He would randomly throw them in the sand trap then play them as they lay, some lying worse than others. Deal with

each shot mentally and try to be creative in your execution. They may not all come out but when you do have a perfect lie in a bunker on the golf course you will feel much more confident about the outcome.
