#### Line up the Palms

How to make sure your hands work together during the swing

Proper positioning of the hands is more important than most club golfers realize; in fact, it's even more important than they will make themselves accept. Make sure your hands are unified on the grip, with your palms more or less facing each other and your right palm facing roughly in the same directions as the clubface.
