Ricardo Santos at impact; weight into the left side; hips rotated and right side released; hips, legs, arms and hands meeting the ball together at impact. The result of this synergy is a complete balanced follow through.

What every amateur can do to improve is to allow the body to "make way" for the arms and hands to deliver the golf club to, and through the ball, into a balanced finish.
