Report from the Greens Committee

The whole committee met on the 1st November including Marco and course Director Christophe. It needs to be said that for many reasons it has proved difficult to have a full attendance on some occasions because of other commitments. Indeed this meeting was squeezed in before the full committee meeting an hour later! It is always better to have a "full house" for discussion.

The writer had received several comments from members since our last meeting and these were as follows

- 1. Greens are very true but slow.
- 2. The holes seem to be raised on some greens, is this poor cutting of the hole?
- 3. The bunkers appear to have had more sand in some
- 4. The fairways are the best for many years but there are some dry spots on Pines and Corks.

In answer to number 1 Marco and the writer took the Stimp reading from the practice putting green. We chose as flat an area as possible and measured in two directions. It was of some surprise to us both that in one direction the reading was just over 10 (fast) but in the opposing direction just under 7 (slow). This would therefore be 8.5. This can only be accounted for by grain which we didn't expect!

Marco is however aware of the issues and trying for an overall speed of 8.5 plus to 10. We have in the past achieved 11.5 but even the professions thought this was too fast!

2. The committee were told that wherever possible the plate is used to cut new holes but sometimes using the cutter without the plate is a better and cleaner operation particularly where the ground is soft?

3. Some new sand has been introduced but very little. We aim to have the sand condition as close as possible to the bunker to the left of the green on 2 of Corks. The members of the committee seem to have had more success in this bunker and we hope it is not just good luck but better sand control!

Finally 4, yes we have some dry patches often on fairways where the elevation and slope causes the irrigation to be less successful. We have also had problems with two main pumps which provide water to some sprinklers. Marco will see how we can improve this situation.

The committee and management believe that the new team of green staff (two new men are being recruited) have settled well to the challenges which they faced over the last few months and the course is well presented from tees to green. Stripes on the fairways and second cuts give a profession appearance. The few brown patches on some greens where the weed grass has died back should recover very quickly.

The course is being fed once more this month and we should see further improvement.

Lastly the committee have asked management for a new tractor which Marco says we need. Also we have repeated our concerns relating to the state of the calcada.

We are seeing firm evidence of overall improvement but we are not complacent. Still some way to go!
