

Introduction from the Captain - Mr Alan Bentley

January is a busy month in the Algarve with Pinheiros Altos hosting two major events, back to back.

The first of the two was the Algarvian Invitational which is now in its 8th year and was played over 4 courses, Pinheiros Altos, Quinta North, Quinta South and San Lorenzo.

This year the event was won by Welsh golfer Philip Price after shooting three impressive rounds of 69, he won the tournament on the 2nd hole playoff against Gary Wolstenholme, to claim the trophy and the accompanying 7,000 euro.

The second event was the Pro Am which is in its 5th year and was again played over the 4 courses. 62 teams competed during the week, and amazingly for the 4th year in a row, David Coupland from the UK took home the Pro prize with a brilliant score of 25 under par for the 4 rounds, Nick Lane's team with a score of 59 under par won the team event.

Pinheiros was well represented by 5 teams in the Pro Am, with John Linley's team finishing 2^{nd} and Dermot Hennessy's team finishing 4^{th} .

The PA ladies team of Mai Markey, Zoe Pirret and Fiona Thomson also finished in a very creditable 18th place.

As an aside there was positive feedback from the Pros who emphasised that the Pinheiros Altos course is now in greatly improved condition. So congratulations must go to all those involved in the ongoing work.

As a part of our new arrangements with Sau Lorenzo January saw the first men's roll up and Monthly stableford events to be held at the venue, with 50 players turning out to play Sau Lorenzo, something of a record we think.

Congratulations to Philippa Clancy our winner with 37 points and the runner up Graham Lee with 36, as usual a close-run thing.

As usual there will be plenty to look forward to in February, with the annual Quinta do Lago and Pinheiros Social golf day, plus our Valentines' competition and towards the end of the month Men's Pairs Match-play event

Director of Golf - Monthly Report

The highlight of January 2020 after the New Year 's day scramble was the Algarvian Invitational Senior tournament & the Algarvian Charity Pro AM.

The 8th Algarvian Invitational was once more organized as a joint venture with Laranjal and played over Pinheiros Altos Pines-Corks course and at Laranjal course over 3 competitive rounds of Golf. The turn-out for this tournament was the largest ever with 144 players and 90 top senior professionals. There was even a large waiting list of players to enter. The prize money was €35.500 which also was the highest ever for the Algarvian Invitational which would not have been possible without our 2 main Sponsors Pinheiros Altos member Mr. John Waters and owner of Quinta do Lago Mr. Denis O'Brian.

The weather over the 3 days was amazing and the sunshine was present every day even than a little bit cold in the mornings but all the players were amazed with the climate in January in the Algarve.

On the start of the final day we 11 players 2 under or better all within 4 shots of the leaders Philip Price & Miguel Angel Martin who were tied at 6 under par for the 2 opening days. On the last day Gary Wolstenholme went out on the pines and shot 30 (6 under for the front nine) putting him in the lead of the tournament at that point. Gary Wolstenholme double buggy the 17th hole (8th on corks) and went one behind Philip Price. On the last hole Philip Price finished with a bogey which meant both Gary Wolstenholme & Philip Price were tied on 9 under Par.

The tournament winner had to be decided on a sudden death playing the 18^{th} hole (9^{th} Corks) and on the second time out on the same hole Philip Price hit the pin with his second shot and almost went in but went on to birdie the hole and win the tournament as the first Welsh man to win the Algarvian Invitational and the $\[\in \] 7.000$ prize money for first spot.

Congratulations to Philip Price on his win in the Algarvian Invitational 2020 but also on winning last year's Staysure European Senior Order of Merit!

The tournament was a huge success and all players were very compliment on the condition of both courses and also many mentions on the Pinheiros Altos greens which many mentioned as the best greens they had played for a while! We are already planning with Quinta do Lago the tournament for next year which will be played in early January 2020.

Following the Algarvian Invitational we also organized in Partnership with Quinta do Lago, San Lorenzo & Dona Filipa hotel the 5th Algarvian Charity Pro Am which was played over Quinta do Lago South & North, San Lorenzo & Pinheiros Altos. Again, another record was broken and I am not only talking about the scores but about the attendance as the Pro Am had 62 teams and 248 players enjoying another fantastic week. This must be the biggest Pro Am ever organized in the Algarve! The Pro Am was played over the 4 courses every day and Brian Evans, Mario Vitoria, Roger Caliço and myself each had their course to look after. The team worked very hard and the week went very smoothly even with one rainy day on the last round but everyone continued to play and finished their round making us the organizers very proud.

The winners were Nick Lane team with Vlada Alexeeva, John Sheynkman & Bogdan Bigus as his 3 amateurs with a score of 59 under par for the 4 days which might sound a lot but was only 2 points clear of the second place where Pinheiros Altos member John Linley managed to take his dream team with David Morland as the Pro, Josee Lacasse & Stephen Hibbitts as the other 2 amateurs!

As last year we had 2 different prize money, one for the 50 years old and over and the other for the players under 50 years old.

The individual Pro score was won for the seniors by David Morland shooting 23 under par for the 4 rounds and the youngsters prize money was for the fourth year running for European Tour Player David Coupland who shot 25 under par for the 4 days and an outstanding 64 on Quinta do Lago North. Local Pro Miguel Gaspar was 3rd overall shooting 17 under Par. David Morland went on to take second spot in the Senior Tour Qualifying School which will guarantee him a card for the Staysure Senior Tour.

The level of golf played over the 2 weeks was amazing and just shows the quality players that are now repetitively coming back to play in both tournaments.

On a personal note I would like to thank all the staff involved from Pinheiros Altos & Quinta do Lago in organizing both tournaments and specially the green staff as well as all the golf staff as & the hotel staff who looked after the players off the course.

A big thank you on my behalf for the continued support from John Waters in both tournaments. He was the mentor to start such tournaments in 2013 and it has grown every year since.

Winter Medal was won by Susan Russell with a score of 69 leading by 6 shots the rest of the field. This is definitely a case for the Handicap committee.

The January Stableford this year was played in San Lorenzo and we had the best turn out for years with 50 players which is great to see that the interest in playing San Lorenzo boost the numbers of the monthly Club competition and as you know there will be more to come. Philippa Clancey managed to win the stableford with a score of 37 points!

I would like to remind every member who play in competitive golf that you should make sure your handicap is active meaning having 4 qualifying scores over the last 12 months in order to claim victory in board competition. Any member whose handicap is not active will not be eligible to win board competitions. The 4 qualifying scores can be played in regular tournaments or extra day scores handed in the Golf Office for recording.

I am delighted to announce that Tony Hickey has accepted to be the candidate nominated by the committee to be the future Vice-Captain as from the next AGM while his wife Paula Burke Hickey will be the Lady Vice Captain. I am sure that both of them will be a great credit to the Golf Committee and their experience will bring a lot to the Club and I look forward to be able to work with them in developing the Golf Club over the next few years.

The committee has nominated David Markey to be the candidate of the committee to run for President of the Club for re-election at the AGM on 9th April 2020.

Additional nominations for Vice Captain or President may be proposed and each additional nomination should be supported by 4 principal Members in writing on or before 26th March 2020 into the Golf Office.

Andy & Sue Georges will be taking over their roles of Captains in April and I can assure you we are looking at a very active and

fun year ahead as they are already planning many activities on the Golf Course as well as off the Golf course.

If any members would like to stand for election as one of the 2 members representative on the Golf Committee, they should notify the golf office, proposed & seconded by principal members in writing on or before Thursday 26th March 2020.

Report from the Greens Committee

The committee has not been able to meet since our last report due to a number of different issues but we hope to publish a more detailed report on the course next month.

The writer is due to meet with the owner's representative, Ruben Paula, together with Christophe, and some of the financial issues for 2020 therefore remain to be confirmed.

We are however pleased that the tining of the fairways and the plan to fertilize the course remains in the calendar for this month.

We are also pleased that although there was some fungal disease on Corks 1 and some dollar spot disease on some of the greens, (mainly Olives), these have been treated very quickly and have recovered well.

The removal of the bunker on the left of Pines 9 has been well received and we believe it reflects the committees wish to make the course "fairer" without necessarily easier.

The new ladies tee on 2 of Pines is another example of a tee which does not reduce the difficulty of the hole (as the bunker is on a direct line to the green) but the ladies will not have to avoid over hanging tree branches. We hope to have it in play when Marco is satisfied the turf has established.

Work has still to be done on enlarging the men's tee on 8 of Corks and there is still work to be done generally on improving all the tees fertility and appearance. Marco the course Manager has applied much sand on the fairways. This is in accordance with STRI plan and until it has been washed in the committee feel that the drop and place rule should be expanded to allow dropping on non-heavily sanded parts of the fairway. Undue advantage should not be the result but allow a proper strike to be executed.

We believe that the greens staff under the management of Marco are working well and the course presents a challenge to members and visitors alike and with excellent putting surfaces we feel confident that the reputation of the PA courses will continue to improve. Our great advantage over our competitors is that 4 hour rounds are a "reality" and not just a "wish".

Maintaining a golf course raises many challenges and we are often the victims of unusual weather conditions. There is evidence also of a failure by visitors who do not appreciate the need to repair pitch marks and not to drive their buggies to the edge of greens. Yes really!

If members have any particular issues with the course lay out we are ready to consider changes if the resources are available and the owners and committee agree. This does not mean filling in the water hazards!

We are hoping for a mild but reasonably wet spring. We still need more rain.
