Report from the Greens Committee

The full committee met on the 13 February and it was agreed that the writer and Christophe should discuss with the owner's representative, Ruben Paula, whether the extraordinary expenditure planned for 2020 could still go ahead.

Due to holiday and other commitments that meeting only took place on the 10^{th} of March.

Between those two dates a lot has changed! The outbreak of the Coronavirus has altered the budget expectations of all holiday destinations and the writer anticipated that the club would feel these effects.

Members will recall that we and management hoped to tackle the problems of poor irrigation particularly on Olives and also to replace and improve some of our more aged machinery. The budget for only these two items was at least €200,000.

The good news is that we believe that the normal but not inconsiderable budget for "maintenance and feeding" can be maintained. The extraordinary expenditure will have to be delayed until such time as the owners can calculated the reductions in income over this year and calculate when the hoped for "upturn" will happen.

By way of explanation all normal bookings for both hotels and flights to Europe have seen substantial cancellations. We still believe that members will continue to support the club but visitors will reduce. The committee still believe that the condition of the course is fundamental to the success of PA notwithstanding that the members enjoy many benefits of social activities and managed members playing times.

We are perhaps fortunate that the course under the management of Marco and his team is we believe in as good a condition as for many years. This is a result of better management of our resources and the professional guidance from the STRI consultants. We are of course disappointed that we cannot for the time being, go that step further to bring the course to its ultimate condition.

Marco and his team will continue with the plans which we have highlighted in our recent reports, this includes feeding, scarifying and tining when appropriate and working on improving both tees and fairways.

Trees highlighted for removal will be cut and bunkers improved wherever possible.

Lastly we hope the higher temperatures in the next few months may destroy the virus and that the "threat" from government to close borders will not be necessary!

The writer believes being outside is safer than being inside!
