

#### A FEW OF THE IDEAS:

**Picnic in PA Park** – on the driving range with music and film or concert on large screen, bring your own picnic blanket, socially distanced dancing. Picnic baskets provided. Bring your own corkscrew!

**Cross Country Golf** – maybe using Pines and/or Corks instead of / in addition to Olives.

Food and Prizes dependant on rules at the time.

**Fastest Round of Golf in The World** – One ball is played, people wait (socially distanced) at different parts of the course and the person closest to where the ball comes to rest plays it etc.etc. The first one or two «practice round/s» will be filmed, then we go for the «World Record»!

Members Concert «PA's Got Talent» — Individuals or small groups present their ideas /proposed acts to a special committee who selects the best. If we have too many, we can keep them for a second concert?! The Dress Rehearsal concert can be specially for the PA Staff, members could make/ provide drinks and snacks for them. Tickets will be sold, the concert will be filmed and members can buy a copy, proceeds to the Charity.

**Relay Golf** – A Team of 4 players, A & C both play first hole, B & D play second hole etc. There are Two Objectives; the speed of the game and the score.

We are finally back operating with 27 holes still with some limitation in staff required by the government to avoid having too many staff operating at the same time.
