## Report from the Greens Committee

The committee have not met since our last report but Director Christophe felt the members should be brought up to date on course conditions.

The back ground to this report is that the Corona 19 lock down and the failure by the owners to provide funds for both staff and course maintenance has put the green staff under substantial pressure. Having said that and the writer having played other courses believes Marco and his team are to be applauded for presenting a course which both appeals to the eye and plays well. We know the greens staff are as frustrated as we are!

San Lourenco which has opened up to members seems better but in reality, they are having similar problems but water supply is better and the course is much «quieter» than PA. It is Marco's father who is doing an excellent job there.

#### What are the problems?

1. The owners had promised substantial increased investment in excess of the last few years! This was to improve irrigation management, particularly on Olives and the continuing process of sanding and feeding in conjunction with scarifying and tining. The failure to supply adequate water and the chemical to prevent water running off slopes can be seen in browning patches on many fairways. We are not used to this! However, those who play «link golf» will see nothing unusual in brown fairways during hot dry summers in the UK!

2. Our course equipment is very «long in the tooth». We need new and more efficient equipment to bring the course up to the standard of our neighbours. This again is promised!

We know that Corana19 has hit the leisure industry very hard and appreciate that applies to our owner.

### Conclusion.

We have a course which is repeated praised by visiting professions and visitors alike as providing one of the best challenges of golf in Portuguese. We have a loyal membership and staff who have acted with exceptional generosity over the last 4 months in keeping the course open and providing reasonable facilities to members.

The greens committee are of course frustrated by promises of funds about to be available which do not materialize. Members have paid their subscriptions and should expect those funds at the very least to be used for the golf course and club house?

We are not surrendering but will double our attempts to put these issues right!

Patience is a virtue and we know how difficult it is very many members but we remain committed to PA.
