Colin Glennon managed to win the November medal with a score of 69 while Tim Russell managed 39 points to win the St Andrews Stableford.

As some of you may know there has been a few cases of Covid-19 within the club, a total of 4 that we are aware all related to the beginning of December and therefore all competitions were cancelled until 25th December. Fortunately, there has been no more cases and the Boxing Day will be played on 26th December and the Stableford on San Lorenzo the following day.

Report from the Greens Committee

Duncan Evans and the writer met with Marco on Friday the 17th in the absence of both David Ford who was away and Christophe who was on vacation.

Marco reported that December had been both unusually warm and wet! He had received some funding which enabled him to both fertilize the greens and apply 4 applications of sand.

Until further funding is available from JJW he will be unable to apply more sand or fertilizer.

At any time this is not ideal but it could be worse as at this time of the year growth of the grass usually reduces very much with cooler nights and reduced daylight. It is however a priority that substantial funding is available very soon as the committee and Marco see 2021 as a year when the course can be fully restored to its full potential with proper investment.

The committee is also concerned that the ability of Marco to keep the rough to a manageable length is very much hampered by the lack of modern equipment! Members will be aware of the rough on Olives which in places is so long as to be «unplayable» We have been sharing a rough cutting mower with San Lourenco but it is not an ideal situation but Marco hopes with dryer conditions he will be able to reduce the rough grass areas.

The committee have been very aware of the financial difficulties facing PA and we remain of the view that Marco and his team have done a remarkable job in providing members and visitors with a well presented and very «playable» course. Members and visitors alike have been complimentary of the course condition and there is no doubt that the work done by Marco and his team have been crucial to that success.

Summary of present position.

The «weed» grasses on the greens and burnt areas have all but disappeared. This process would have been quicker with more fertilizers!

The fairways remain in the main good to excellent. Few fairways have bare patched and whilst the committee support «placing» this is mainly because of the very wet conditions.

The changes to the course of pruning excessive tree growth and removing some bunkers, has we believe been accepted as fair and improved play.

2021 is a challenging year as the UK moves into very difficult times. We hope the vaccine promised for» Covid 19» will bring some relief to «tourism» and the owners ability to fund improvements as will the promise of new investment from a third party?

Marco and the committee want to see a programme to improve our bunkers which can be done with little funding. The slopes are too steep and need reducing and the sand needs «firming».

We remain optimistic but we appreciate both the member's loyalty and that of our essential course staff led by Marco!
