Christophe will be sending a list of the competition proposed this month however until later in the month we are not sure if the social side will be allowed. As things stand we are hopeful that in June these will restart



Bernie was one of the very first property owners on the Pinheiros Altos estate and consequently one of the first Club members. Long before the Club had any formal structure with appointed officers and committees with defined responsibilities, Bernie formed a close, powerful working relationship with Brian Evans, Director of



Golf. From this relationship there evolved a kind of Club atmosphere that potential members found attractive. There was no constitution, no rule book, n precedents, everyone was feeling their way, there was kind of wild west atmosphere but underpinned by determination to make a great golf club.

When, eventually, the Club structure was formalised it was right and proper that Bernie be appointed first President because, de facto, that was the role he had been filling alongside Brian Evans for some time. Whilst he felt proud of the honour he made it clear that he would take on the role for one year.

There are very few members who have any memories of Bernie but I can assure the membership that we should grateful for his impactful contribution to the establishment of Pinheiros Altos Golf Club.

Above all Bernie was a dedicated family man and I have been in touch with his beloved wife Irmgard to pass on the Club's condolences. Irmgard herself was a keen club member and very influential in contributing to the development of the very strong Ladies section of the Club. She wishes to be remembered to her many friends in the Club and has expressed a determination to visit Pinheiros Altos when the covid restrictions allow.

MADRINHA GOLF PROGRAMME

The history of Madrinha (God Mother) within the ladies' section was originally to pair up experienced players with new and inexperienced players. The two would play together as a team, in betterball match play format against another golfer and her Madrinha. This was initiated by Helen Mills and the winners were presented with the Madrinha Trophy.



As the years went on, there were very few new players, so the trophy was changed to a competition held on one day.

The committee felt that we should look to re- introduce the original concept and, after discussions with Helen, we have decided on the following...

- a) To invite our new and inexperienced players to sign up to be part of the Madrinha Golf Programme
- **b)** To invite our experienced players to sign up to be part of the programme.
- c) For the ladies on each list to "pair" up to play together for 9 holes on Tuesday or Thursday, or other days if preferred.
- **d)** Where possible, when both players sign up for Wednesday fun comps to put them in the same fourball.
- **e)** To plan in the coming months, either a round robin match play challenge or a one day event next year.

We will shortly send an e mail to explain how to get involved. The experienced players (Madrinhas) will not necessarily be low handicap golfers.

Our objective is to introduce rules and etiquette, as well as various formats of golf competitions, including matchplay to our newer and inexperienced players.

This will be a fun programme – everyone involved will have signed up with the intention of wanting to help or learn something. No one was born with a natural golfing talent, some were lucky enough to learn as young children, but most of us started this game as adults and have experienced everything that the nervous golfer believes is exclusive to themselves.

A couple of golf appropriate quotes to keep in mind....

"I hear and I forget. I see and I remember. I do and I understand."

"The more you accept that every shot is not going to be perfect, and that's completely OK because it's the nature of the sport, the easier it is to be calm and realistic."

Report from the Greens Committee

This report is made without the benefit of the full committee and only to bring members both away and playing the golf course a feeling for where we are in maintaining the course.

- 1. Against the most difficult conditions the course remains open. Seven members of the green's manpower out of a normal 22/23 are looking after Pines and Corks and hope to open Olives in the foreseeable future.
- 2. The team is managed by Leonel Silva as Marco has temporarily suspended his contract. We hope Marco will return when the owners funding allows. However Leonel is doing an excellent job!
- 3. We have been able to apply chemical for "dollar spot" on the greens on three occasions. Fertilizer was last applied on the greens in February. We have not been able to sand or fertilize the fairways but we have made urgent requests for all necessary chemicals and are promised these will be supplied.


- 4. The rough had become unmanageable in some place but we now have the rough mower back in use after urgent repairs. We hope losing balls in the clover may soon be over!
- 5. There is no doubt that we are in a very perilous situation and we have made it clear to management that investment in the course is vital for the future success of PA! Not just for members but for the future financial stability of the club and the owners of PA property.

The staff have been heroic and the course is testament to the team in that many members realising our difficulties are amazed at how playable are both Pines and Corks with quick greens and firm surfaces.

We are grateful that members have in the main been equality loyal and understanding when supporting the club.

We hope in next report we will be able to be more positive for the future!

Angus Flanagan - Walker Cup



Young Pinheiros Altos Member **Angus Flanagan** went undefeated on the final day of competition as the Walker Cup concluded Sunday at Seminole Golf Club in Juno Beach, Fla.

After splitting his matches Saturday, the Woking, England, native earned a tie in his foursomes (alternate shot) match Sunday morning and then claimed a victory in singles play in the afternoon. With one point awarded for a win and half a point for a tie, Flanagan finished the weekend with 2.5 points, good for third on the Great Britain and Ireland Squad and fifth among all competitors.

The United States retained the Walker Cup title for the third straight time with a 14-12 victory.

Playing with Ben Schmidt against the United States duo of Davis Thompson and Cole Hammer, Flanagan helped engineer a terrific comeback and salvage a point for GB&I.

Thompson/Hammer came out hot out of the gates, going 4 Up in just five holes. Flanagan/Schmidt captured No. 6 to get back within three, but two holes later another victory for the Americans put the deficit at four with just 10 holes to play.

A birdie on No. 9 bested a par and Flanagan/Schmidt got down three. The competing duos then tied on each of the next five holes, leaving the European duo down three with just four holes to play. The comeback began with a birdie on No. 15 versus a



par for the U.S., while each team recorded a par on No. 16. The tee shot from Schmidt on the par-3 17th landed in the bunker, but Flanagan's shot out rolled to within a couple feet of the hole to cut the US lead to just one with one hole to play.

Both squads were over par on No. 18 but the GB&I duo was able to keep it to a bogey, while the Americans recorded a double to split the match.

In singles play, Flanagan earned a 1 Up victory over William Mouw, a sophomore from Pepperdine, in a tightly-contested match where only five holes were won.

Flanagan struck first with a birdie on No. 3, but Mouw tied it up on No. 6 with a par. Flanagan only needed two holes, though, to take the lead back as his par on No. 8 topped a bogey for Mouw. The duo then matched each other on the next seven holes, leaving Flanagan 1 Up with three holes remaining.

On No. 16, with the pin location far back on the green, Flanagan rolled his chip shot to within about three feet to secure a birdie and two-shot lead. Mouw then captured No. 17 to extend the match.

On the final hole of the day Flanagan buried a long, sweeping par putt, while Mouw missed his birdie attempt that would've tied the match, giving Flanagan the victory and the point for GB&I. Up next, Flanagan returns to collegiate play at the NCAA Regional in Noblesville, Ind., May 17-19.

If you wish to only display your name or email, please contact Cristina to set your profile with the details you only want to show.


Once you have sign up, you will have access to the club diary, competitions and other useful information.
