# Azure-winged Magpie

You will have seen these birds all over the golf course in prolific numbers. One of their favourite feeding techniques, which they practice regularly in PA, is hanging onto the side of a tree and then pouncing onto an insect on the ground. You will also see them hovering about a metre above the fairway or rough before they pounce.

Like the black and white Common Magpie, they are predators and omnivores, but they are not considered birds of prey. I have seen Azure-winged Magpies attack and kill baby sparrows in my garden with their beaks and claws, and then eat them.

The other observation I have made from my garden over the years has been large groups of them collecting as dusk approaches, and then flying collectively in the same direction. They form colonies or large family groups, and roost together. Invariably during the day, you will see them moving around in a group of about 3-6 birds. Some of you may have heard these birds referred to as Iberian Azul Magpies, as I had. And so I conducted some research to try and establish more information, and in doing so I discovered an interesting fact. There are very large numbers of Azure-winged Magpies all along the eastern seaboard of Asia, and there is a comparatively small population on the Iberian Peninsula. They are not found anywhere else in the world other than these two locations. The widely held explanation is that, as with my story not too long ago about the black headed weavers being imported into the Algarve as pets on ships, the Azure-winged magpies were brought back to Spain and Portugal on early oriental trading ships as pets.

# Director of Golf - Monthly Report

November started with our usual Foursomes Championship which for a 4 somes was quiet well attended with even many married couples giving it a go. However, the combinations of 2 ladies seemed to be the strongest one as they cleared all the nett prizes with only one man figuring in the nett prizes, the gross was won by Gerry Naughton & Liam Edwards while the Foursomes Champions which is the best net score aggregate were Ingrid Blain & Heather Conroy with scores of 69 & 67.

The November Medal and the St Andrews stableford were also won by 2 ladies, the medal by Dawn Warnock with a score of 67 And the stableford by Zoe Pirret with a score of 39.

The Annual Subscriptions were sent on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 as normal and at that time I am confident that we have the resources necessary to improve the course over a certain period

of time as I have received approval of a maintenance plan which is considerably more than just our normal budget.

The news in early December of a re-finance plan for JJW was even more exciting and followed by the announcement of Intercontinental joining forces with JJW will enhance what already are Iconic hotels in the Algarve. I believe this could be the start of many more developments within the group and a long term partnership with our membership which has shown such strength and loyalty during Covid-19. The membership will surely benefit from the future investments.

Already the Golf Titles are selling and I foresee many more sales until the end of the year and into the next year when investments start to be visible. The Golf Title are at the moment €17.500 and are going to be increased somewhere between €22.000 & 25.000.

The company will be charging its commission (5% or €2.000 whichever is the highest) as the Golf Title will now be over the €20.000. Golf Titles will be solely traded through the company and direct sale will have to be dealt by the company and continue to be signed off by the company. Any Title with any debts owned on it will not be allowed to be sold or transferred. These rules are important to protect the increased value of the Golf Title.

We are now working on improving every aspect of the golf course and while we know it will take some time to get to the level we want it, I am confident the improvement will be continuous through next year. The calçada path are well on the way as we have finished the front of the clubhouse and moving to 1st on Corks before Christmas and will be doing the Olives paths during January 2022. I have already made contact with Conor from STRI which I am having a zoom call on 27th December and another one with the green-keeper in January 2022 in view for a visit in May 2022. Batteries for Buggies in Pinheiros, San Lorenzo & Penina have been ordered and paid for to recover the original fleets of buggies on all 3 courses. Most important investment approved for this year is the installation of the satellites for the irrigation which will solve a lot of the problems we face with irrigation in the Summer. This with the purchase of about 100 new sprinklers will improve drastically the management of the water on the course. We are also working on many more capital expenditure which will be looked at in a view to be part of the first phases of the refinance.

I am very excited with the future and what a contrast with 12 months ago where payments to staff were delayed and cash flow next to nothing. The staff & members loyalty will not be forgotten and the strength of the Club will continue to grow and re-establish Pinheiros Altos as the best in the area.

As I am writing this newsletter I am flying on my holidays with my family and having left Ross to look after the usual Turkey Flutter which I am sure will be well supported and also followed by the Boxing Day.

We have decided to run our usual New Year Day Texas scramble and hope that restrictions will not interfere. So please if you are in the Algarve make sure you sign for it and I will be looking forward to see many there. Presentation if it takes place will be outside.

I would like to remind all the members that the deadline to pay your annual subscription 2022 is the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 and that any members unpaid will not be allowed to play the course as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022. Most of the members have paid in mass before the 10th December showing once again fantastic support.

I would like to wish all the members and my staff a Merry Christmas & wish all lots of health and happiness for the new year to come.

I look forward to see many of you in the New Year for a great year of golfing!!!

## Report from the Greens Committee

The Committee met on Friday the 10th December in the absence of David Ford who was abroad but with whom the writer had a discussion before he left.

It is the Greens Committee job to keep the members advised on course condition and plans for the future where necessary. We cannot comment on political issues. It also has to be said that we cannot make policy but only argue for greater course investment where we feel it is necessary.

The Director of Golf has communicated to all members a «maintenance and Operation Plan» for 2022. The Committee considered the plans and believe this is appropriate and indeed generous in scale. We would pick out two aspects. Firstly, a new irrigation system for the original 18 holes (as in SL) and the appointment of the STRI to advise on course management. Although expenditure on new machinery is not itemised we believe the owners accept this will be necessary in the coming year. To date repairs have been fully financed.

It cannot be said too often that the course has suffered very badly over the last 12 months from a lack of investment. The Presidents recent letter confirms that a programme of re financing by JJW has opened the way for much increased investment in course maintenance, including fertilizers chemicals and more man power.

All staff are now fully paid including their annual bonus payments. Marco is still 2/3 men short.

The last month has already shown improved greens and rough maintenance. The greens are now running at 9.5/10 on the «Stimp meter» (this may a little too fast for some!).

Members and visitors have commented on the improved condition of the course in the last month. Marco believes that in the next 3 or 4 months the course will be in the sort of condition which we expect and will challenge our neighbours courses.

The Committee remain of the view that the 27 holes at PA are an outstanding challenge to all golfers and this is a view shared by most professionals.

### **Fairways**

The Director, and the Committee, have agreed that the fairways will remain under the agreed «place and play» concession until there is new growth whilst there has been some fertilizer in the form of urea on fairways growth requires higher temperatures than we are currently enjoying. The end of February should start to see better growth. The kikuya grass has successfully taken hold on most fairways.

#### Greens

The «weed grass» has as predicted disappeared but Marco hopes to be able to prevent its reappearance next year! It requires a chemical application in much the same way as does «Crab grass» which is seasonal as is the fungicide expected in the next month or two! Herbicide application is planned.

Marco believes that over seeding some of the bare patches on the greens is working and does not need more turfing. Time will tell!

#### Tees

Tees are in the main better than we feared and should continue to improve in the warmer weather.


### **Bunkers**


## **WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM - KNOW HOW TIPS**

Does this sound familiar? — Standing on the first tee and you or one of your playing partners doesn't know their handicap index?

Most of us now carry phones with 3G or better, it is easy to register and download the *my.fpg.pt* app and all your information is then at your fingertips anywhere.



If you have not downloaded *my.fpg.pt* you will find instructions on how to do this under the brown button *WHS Handicap Information* if you swipe to the left on the club app.





Once registered, download onto your screen saver with *Remember me* and your login details saved - you have instant access to among other things your: H/C Index, Playing H/C Calculation, Results, etc
