Report from the Greens Committee

After a long absence due to ill health and absenteeism the full committee met with Christophe and the new course manager Antonio Povoas on Tuesday the 27th.

Antonio has worked on several courses including S.L, Quinta and other well known, courses in Portugal. He speaks good English and we were all impressed by his plans going forward and the improvements he has achieved in the few weeks since his appointment.

Antonio was quick to thank Marco for the steps he had put in place and for the fertilizer available to feed the fairways and greens which he applied soon after his arrival.

He is facing a challenging future but does not appear fearful of the prospects.

1.Difficulties.

STRI recommend a work force of 22/24 for PA; we have 17 and effectively, only 14/15 men are working due to holidays and illness. There is a lack of skilled and unskilled workers throughout the Algarve following the Covid lockdown! The cost of transport and government payments to workers has made many workers reluctant to return to work. We need to be more competitive to recruit!

Our history of late payments to staff over previous years cannot be helpful.

The owner's willingness to fund the improvements and replacing worn and old machinery is not yet clear. Christophe has presented a detailed costing for next year. The good news is that the planned computer driven irrigation system planned for approximately 16/18 holes is going ahead. There will be some closed holes in the quiet months for digging trenches for cabling. The process is however now quite quick!

2.STRI who provide independent advice to most of the top courses worldwide would like to see more investment in equipment. Antonio has made a modest request for a leaf blower (we used

to have one) and a tree root cutter. The committee raised the concern of tree roots some months ago. The modern equipment allows roots to be cut in two places doing away with the need to pull roots out of the ground! The machinery is vital for the course and must be funded!

We also need new fairway and rough cutters (these are long overdue)

3. Antonio believes with appropriate chemicals applied at the right time the dollar spot and greens weed grasses can be eradicated as can the crab grasses (all gardeners doubt this)!

The future

We have raised issues on the appearance of some tees (3 of Corks 3 of Pines and more) which need water and feed. Antonio is aware of the problems and improved irrigation is the answer.

Also, the use of buggies is contentious but we must be more disciplined and keep to the paths where possible and essentially keep away from the area 30/40 metres from the greens and prepared frontages. Also access to the fairways from the paths needs to be improved where the railings run without gaps for 150mtrs and more.

Good and perhaps faster greens are our aim: with fairways where we can lift the "placing regime" and where bunkers have the minimum but correct amount of sand to prevent plugging. Beautiful prepared tees are also a great selling point for most golf courses.

We believe these aims are obtainable, we just hope our owners can see this as a very worthwhile investment which will provide substantial returns in the future.

We are always happy to listen to any members particular course concerns.



Access myFPG


- Log into the Player Area on my.fpg.pt
- Click on 'Scorecards'
- · Your scorecard should already be registered





- You will need to include your Marker's federation number
- Click on the Marker tab
- Enter your Marker's Federation No.
- Click Validate
- Click SAVE

- Click on the **Score** tab.
- Enter scores by clicking on the (+) sign to increase the number or use the (-) sign to decrease the number
- If you did not hole out click the 'No Score' button
- Click SAVE
 - Click on the **Definitions** tab
 - Check that all the information regarding the round played are correct
 - Click SAVE
 - Finally make sure to SEND, you may need to click on 'Scorecards' again where you will see under 'Status' to be sent. Click Send.
