

## Report from the Greens Committee

Greens committee report November 2024

The full committee met on the 27 November.

This report is shorter than we would like but it reflects two main developments.

Firstly, whilst the greens staff is at 20 plus, five of that staff are new recruits! They require instruction as noncome from a back ground of working on golf courses! We asked why so many trained staff have left! There are the usual reasons of a young mobile male staff! There is no specific reason!

Secondly the funds required to provide additional equipment and in particular a new fairway cutter and

rough cutter are promised, ordered and expected! Much of the equipment used for maintaining the course is well past normal replacement and requires regular maintenance!

### **Course Condition**

The recent unsettled weather and improved irrigation has brought the fairways very close to their very best! Placing is still in place but the committee would like to see normal non-placing after spring growth and with the new irrigation in place!

There is still much work to be completed on tree roots and where trees need either pruning or cut down! The lobbing of trees is subject to fire risks in the summer months and finding companies who are willing to bring their equipment onto the course is more difficult than we had hoped!

### **Course Tees**

Tees have been rested in some cases and we hope to see more improvement, the first tee on Corks has improved but the trees alongside the tee are owned by others and we cannot reduce them! The poor light there and on 5 tee Pines are a problem!

The first tee on Pines remains our best but has no light issues!

### **Bunkers**

On balance we believe the maintenance has improved but the sand is not the best and solidifies under the first cm or more. Many bunkers are deep with high overhang and need new sand after being digged out! It is a high labour and a skilled job! We have to be patient! Antonio is aware of the problem!

### Rough

The unplayable deep rough with both heavy weed is now much improved and the effect on slow play we hope is now behind us. It was a high labour job and like the root problem requires modern equipment and skilled man power!

### Greens

Dollar spot has been a problem as has weed contamination on many of the greens.

Antonio promised to solve these problems by the end of November and on balance we believe he has succeeded! The greens are still far from perfect and require careful treatment of cutting, use of sand and fertiliser, and we hope to bring the speed up-to 8/9 on the stimp meter!

### Buggy use

Despite the heavy rain the course has not been closed expect in small areas and has played very well. New members and visitors have been surprised how dry the course has remained and we have not seen buggy tyre marks but members must where possible keep to the 90% rule during wet conditions and where they can see tyre marks.

The committee see 2025 as a very challenging year for course condition and the plans in place to insure irrigation and condition are vital to that success.

The committee will remain available to respond to members queries if the staff are not available. Change we are told is good! Let us hope we will see improvement in next year.

### Interclub Report

Our Interclub season ended on the 24th October with a 4-1 victory at home to Boavista. The result meant that Pinheiros Altos finished in third place and, given that points are doubled for the purposes of the league tables, it meant that we missed promotion back to Division One by half a point! Frustrating as that was, every cloud has a silver lining and it is the opinion of most of the team, that the courses that we'll be playing next year are generally superior to those in the Division above. Having not won an away match for two years, we achieved three away wins, a terrific effort and matched only by two other teams out of the 22 across the three Divisions, one of which won Division One and the other achieving promotion from Division Three. However, we committed the cardinal sin of losing at home to Penina and that match became the decisive moment for us.

We commenced the season with a squad of 43, although illness, injury and availability meant that the realistic number was more like 33. Over the course of the season,

25 people were selected to represent the team. In speaking to other captains, this is a far higher number than average, some of whom select from as few as 14 or 15. Still, I appreciate that a number of people will have been frustrated by their lack, or absence, of game time. Only 10 people can be selected at a time and we will always select on the basis of pairings that we believe have the best chance of winning.

I should like to thank all those who represented PA for their skill, commitment and team spirit. I should also like to thank those squad members who provided tremendous support, even if not selected. Finally a big thank you to Vice Captain, Neil Sutton and to Ingrid Blain for their input throughout the season in selection and other ways.
